Atomic Credit Union Scholarship Program has been established to recognize and assist those students in our surrounding areas who desire to further their education. Five \$1,000 non-renewable scholarships will be awarded in the spring of 2012 to a member, or a child or grandchild of a member of Atomic Credit Union, of which said membership was opened prior to September 1, 2011. Applicants must be a 2012 high school graduating senior and have plans to enroll or be currently enrolled in an accredited school of higher education, such as a college, university, business or technical school as a full time student in the fall 2012. Information and applications are available at any of our eleven branch locations in addition to our website at www.2mycu.com.

Criteria for applications:

Applicants must be a member, or a child or grandchild of a member of Atomic Credit Union, of which said membership was opened prior to September 1, 2011. Applicants must also be a 2012 high school graduating senior and have plans to enroll or be currently enrolled in an accredited school of higher education, such as a college, university, business or technical school as a full time student in the fall 2012. In addition, applicants must have obtained a 3.0 or better accumulative GPA on a 4.00 scale **and** a composite score of 21 on the ACT or a 900 Board Score on the SAT, submitted on an official 7th semester transcript.

To be eligible, the following must be submitted in a large manila envelope and received at any of our ten office locations by close of business on **March 30, 2012**:

- (1) Completed application form provided by Atomic Credit Union.
- (2) One letter of recommendation from a neighbor, employer, clergy, etc (excluding immediate family and relatives).
- (3) Two teacher(s) and/or counselor(s) recommendation forms to be placed in separate sealed envelopes.
- (4) Official copy of the applicant's 7th semester transcript, test results, and courses in progress.

All information provided as part of this application will be kept in complete confidence. Funds from the scholarships will be presented to the chosen individuals and made payable to both the student and school at which the student will be attending. Should a recipient of this scholarship choose not to attend an accredited school of higher education, the scholarship funds will be returned to Atomic Credit Union.
